Hematologic/Lymphatic Allergic/Immunologic A problem pertinent ROS inquires about the system directly related to the problem(s) identified in the HPI. DG: The patient's positive responses and pertinent negatives for the system related to the problem should be documented. An extended ROS inquires about the system directly related to the problem(s)

Feb 08, 2017 • CSD: Diagnosis PCR: highly sensitive and specific diagnostic tool Detects Bartonella at sites of skin inoculation, lymph nodes, bone, eye, conjunctivae, paraspinal lesions, liver, spleen, brain Majority of cases resolves in 1 -2 months without any antimicrobial therapy CSD: Treatment Antimicrobial therapy should be considered for patients with:
