Swahili Beyond the Boundaries Alamin M. Mazrui 2007 Africa is a marriage of cultures: African and Asian, Islamic and Euro-Christian. In the process of this contestation, a new synthesis may be emerging that is poised to subject Swahili literature to new kinds of challenges in the politics of identity, compounded by the dynamics and counterdynamics of post-Cold War globalization.
